

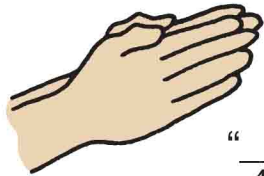
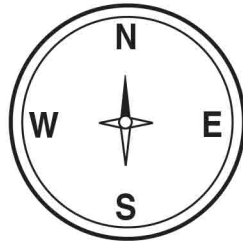
Moses prayed that God would spare the people, and God heard his prayer.

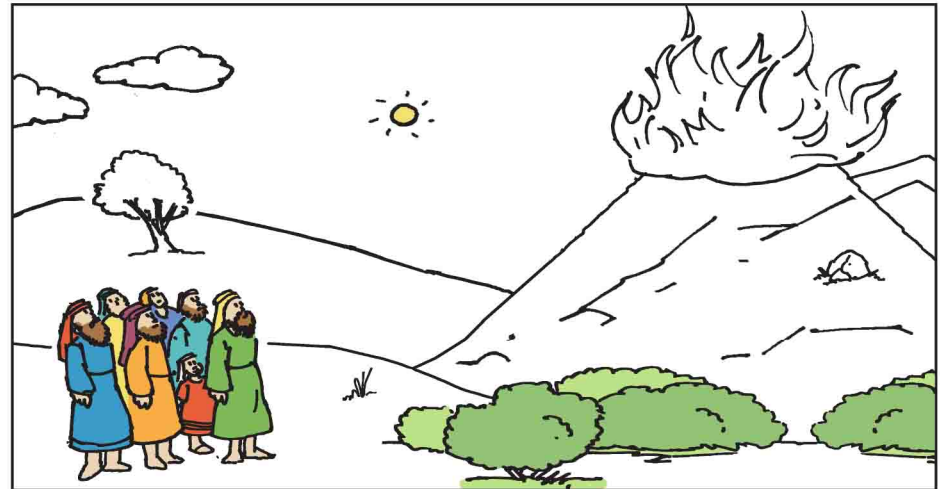

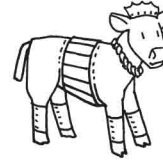
